Ski School: Vail's Ski and Snowboard School is considered the best in the world. [Click Here](#) for more information and to book your lessons directly online. You can also call (970) SKI-VAİL or (800) 475-4543. Due to the complex nature of booking ski school lessons, we recommend booking directly through Vail. We are more than happy to walk through the process with you, but we will need detailed information about each skier/rider.

Lift Tickets: *Don't pay full price at the ticket window!* For the guaranteed lowest prices, **buy online** at [Vail.com](#). Also enjoy the added convenience of receiving your lift tickets prior to your arrival – then go straight to the slopes! **NOTE: When ordering tickets online, they must be purchased 7 days in advance for Domestic purchases, and 14 days in advance for International purchases. PEAKS rates are only available online.**

Additional days purchased at the ticket window must be purchased at the window rate.

All lift ticket products are non-transferable and non-refundable.
